**Station 1: St. Peter Cathedral
(10th and Sassafras Streets)**

The sorrowful mother's child is condemned to death.
A theology of domination endangers the earth and women.

**Station 2: Griswold Park
(13th-15th Streets between Sassafras and Peach)**

A sword will pierce her heart.
"Bomb trains" transect the city.

Station 3: Northwest corner of 10th and State Street
Her child is beaten and abused.
Fossil fuel lifestyle assaults the planet.

**Station 4: Federal Building
(State Street and South Park Row)**
She weeps with her child over Jerusalem.
War ravages children, women, and the earth.

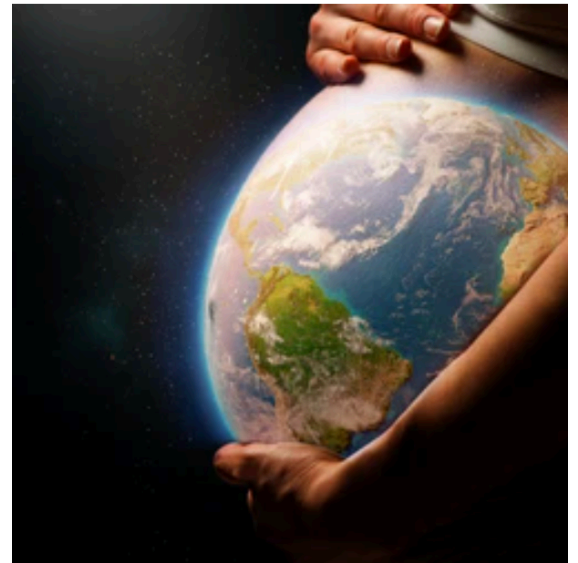
**Station 5: Perry Square stage
(State Street and South Park Row)**
She weeps with other women.
Climate crisis forces families from their homes.

**Station 6: Governor's regional office
(2nd and State)**
Her child is nailed to the cross.
Corporate tax breaks promote fracking.

Station 7: Fishing dock off east State Street
Her child is given vinegar to drink.
Pollution poisons life-giving water.

**Station 8: Dobbins Landing
(North end of State Street)**
She vigils to the last breath.
Pollution smothers children of color.

Station 9: Mount St. Benedict Monastery
She receives his lifeless body.
Climate crisis threatens hope.
